Family Nature Summit Code of Conduct All Summiteers are expected to follow the Summit Code of Conduct. A Summiteer is defined by those attending the Family Nature Summit. In addition, all Faculty, Assistants, Guest Presenters, Contractors, Volunteers or other individuals involved in the Family Nature Summit are considered a Summiteer. 1. Respect all people a. Summiteers will treat all people with respect including fellow summiteers, staff, volunteers and our host site personnel. b. Summiteers will refrain from any behavior that others may find offensive or interfere with their enjoyment of the Summit experience. 2. Respect our location a. Summiteers will care for our host location as we would care for our own home leaving it clean and healthy – a better place because The Summit was there. 3. Respect wildlife a. Summiteers will respect the wildlife at our location giving them space to be wild as we honor their presence at our chosen Summit site. 4. Respect the Earth a. Summiteers will respect the waters by keeping them clean of pollutants and silt b. Summiteers will respect the soil by staying on paths, if available and at a minimum follow the, "Leave No Trace" principles c. Summiteers will respect the plants of the region by protecting their right to grow and flourish 5. Summiteers will comply with all applicable local, state, and federal laws, rules and regulations 6. Violation(s) of the Code of Conduct will be addressed by the Board on a case-by-case basis. The consequences of the infraction will be left up to the discretion of the Board and may lead to the termination of your Family Nature Summit membership.
